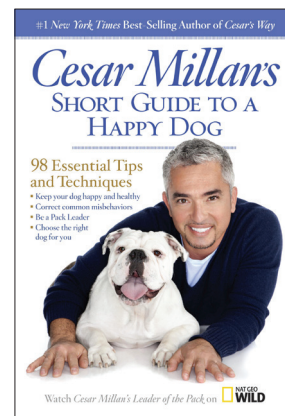


Cesar Millan's SHORT GUIDE TO A HAPPY DOG
