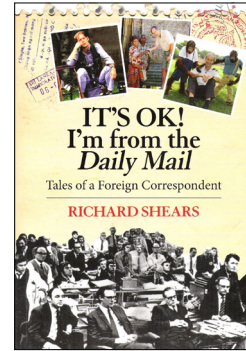


IT'S OK! I'm from the *Daily Mail*
